First Term	*1-2 graduate course(s) *CHM3000H
Second Term	*complete 2 <sup>nd</sup> graduate course *start receiving a research grade based on lab/research performance
Third Term	*seminar by the 13 <sup>th</sup> month of registration if exiting by the last Friday in September/first Friday in October (refer to SGS calendar for the deadline)
Fourth Term	*seminar by the 17 <sup>th</sup> month of registration if exiting by the last Friday in January (refer to SGS calendar for the deadline)
Fifth Term	*seminar by the 20 <sup>th</sup> month of registration if exiting by mid-April (refer to SGS calendar for the deadline) * <b>Biological students complete one seminar usually in the 5th term.</b>
Sixth Term	*seminar by the 25 <sup>th</sup> month of registration if exiting by the last Friday in September/first Friday in October (refer to SGS calendar for the deadline)

Students who are contemplating of transferring to the PhD program must complete 2 x 0.5 FCE graduate courses by the end of their 1<sup>st</sup> year in order to qualify. Organic and biological chemistry students are welcome to take the monthly cumulative exams.
