



Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund Cover Page

Awards categorized as “OSOTF” (Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund) or “OTSS” (Ontario Trust for Student Support) are open to eligible applicants who meet the following criteria, in addition to the criteria specified by the individual award.

At the time of application students must:

1. **Demonstrate financial need**
2. **Are Canadian citizens, permanent residents of Canada or protected persons** under subsection 95(2) of the [Immigration and Refugee Protection Act \(Canada\)](#) at the time of the application; and
3. **Are residents of Ontario*** at the time of the application, as defined by one of the following criteria:
 - o Student has always lived in Ontario (i.e. Ontario is the only Canadian province/territory that the student has lived in); or
 - o Ontario is the last province in which student has lived for 12 months in a row without being a full-time postsecondary student; or
 - o Student lives in Ontario now and has lived in Canada for less than 12 months in a row.

Notes:

If student is married/common-law, student can be considered an Ontario resident if: Spouse has always lived in Ontario; or Ontario is the last province in which spouse has lived for 12 months in a row without being a full-time postsecondary student; or **Both** of these statements are true: a) Student lives in Ontario now; and b) Student and spouse have lived in Canada for less than 12 months in a row.

If student qualifies as a dependent student, student is considered an Ontario resident if: Ontario is the last province in which parent(s) have lived for at least 12 months in a row; or **Both** of these statements are true: a) Student lives in Ontario now; and b) Student and parent(s) have lived in Canada for less than 12 months in a row.

*The above requirements are established by OSAP to determine Ontario residency for OSAP purposes.
